Below you will find information regarding type rating training along with our current price list. Type rating training can only be carried at our approved facility at Redhill Aerodrome.

Initial Issue Type Rating Course Requirements

Any type rating course, including ground school shall be completed within the 6 months preceding the skills test.

Single Engine Piston (SEP)

Minimum course requirements: 5 hours flight training, plus the flight test and ground school

Single Engine Turbine (SET) under 3175kg

Minimum course requirements: 5 hours flight training, plus the flight test and ground school.

Single Pilot, Multi Engine Turbine (MET)

Pre Requisites for Initial Multi engine turbine ratings require completion of a pre entry approved course, or for the applicant to have passed the ATP(H) theoretical exams. For applicants not meeting the above criteria they shall have completed at least 70 hours as Pilot in Command (PIC) of helicopters (Reference: JAR FCL 2; 2.255).

Minimum Course Requirements: 8 hours flight training, plus the flight test and ground school.

Additional Type Rating Course Requirements

Single Engine Piston (SEP) – Single Engine Piston (SEP) (*Includes R22, R44 and other aircraft types NOT listed below**)

Minimum Course requirements: 5 hours flight training, plus the flight test and ground school.

**Listed Aircraft types: Augsta-Bell / Westland / Bell 47, Brantley B2, Breda Nardi HU269, Enstrom ENF28, Hiller UH12, Hughes / Schweitzer HU269*

Single Engine Piston (SEP) – Single Engine Piston (SEP) (**Listed aircraft types only*)

If you are rated on an alternative single piston type, the minimum requirement includes a minimum of 2 hours flight training, plus the flight test and ground school.

**Listed Aircraft types: Augsta-Bell / Westland / Bell 47, Brantley B2, Breda Nardi HU269, Enstrom ENF28, Hiller UH12, Hughes / Schweitzer HU269*

Single Engine Turbine (SET) – Single Engine Turbine (SET)

If you are rated on an alternative single engine turbine type the minimum requirement includes a minimum of 3 hours flight training, plus the flight test and ground school.

Multi Engine Turbine (MET) – Multi Engine Turbine)

if you are rated on an alternative twin-engine helicopter type the minimum requirement includes a minimum of 5 hours flight training plus the flight test and ground school.
